Empowering communities is one of the concepts in community service, one of which is First, IT Training: communities need to be trained in the use of laptops, smartphones, and other digital devices. Especially teenagers need to understand the basics of using smartphones for important matters in village development (Ridwan et al., 2019). Second, Economic Improvement: One of the main focuses of Digital Education Villages is to improve economic conditions in villages (Abdillah & Sholihah, 2023). This effort involves providing training to villagers to develop online businesses, digitally market local products, and find job opportunities in the technology sector.

The success of IT training can be measured by several indicators including Community Participation, Participation of the community in programs, such as attending training and adopting the use of digital technology in daily activities, can also be a measure of program success. Additionally, local economic development such as increased business opportunities and local business growth, is another important indicator (Training & Sampah, 2023).

The Community Service in Bulu Mario village is one of the villages that have implemented an effective approach to address access and knowledge gaps in the technology era. By empowering rural communities with knowledge and skills in digital technology, we can help them benefit from advances in information and communication technology (Rahim et al., 2023). Thus, Bulu Mario Village not only assists rural communities in adapting to technological changes but also stimulates sustainable growth and development at the local level.

These activities include data collection, counseling, training, and evaluation in Bulu Mario Village. Implementation in the field involves teenagers in conducting IT training, and the community service method can be an effective tool in achieving this goal by involving various stakeholders.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Community service aiming to realize IT Training in the technology era is a collaborative effort involving various parties. This activity is conducted to empower rural communities to adopt IT in their daily lives and enhance their quality of life through empowerment programs tailored to their needs. The following are the results of IT training for teenagers in Bulu Mario village.

I even started selling my parents' agricultural products online, which I hadn't thought of before." Additionally, Nurlina, another teenager in the village, also shared her positive experience. "Before, I only used a smartphone for calls and text messages," she said. "Now, I am learning to use apps to help my younger siblings with online learning. From several interviews above, it is evident how the community empowerment program has brought positive changes in the daily lives of the villagers of Bulu Mario.
